## General instructions for all Fall planting bulbs

### All flowerbulbs will be delivered in the Fall at the proper time for planting.

The correct time for planting is in the Fall when soil temperatures in your area approach 55° fahrenheit. Good drainage is essential, never plant bulbs where water collects.

### Get 8-10 weeks of early Spring color in your Garden.

Order the Colorblends Garden Pack Collection of 45 flower bulbs and get over two months of vivid spring color. This collection is selected from the most vigorous bulbs and should provide many seasons of joyous spring blooms. Follow the planting instructions below to give your bulbs the best start.

#### **Tulips** (Bloom time Mid-Season - April/May)

Tulips do best in full sun but will bloom well if they receive 5 to 6 hours of sun a day. Single lines of tulips are always disappointing. If you want a long bed of color plant them in rows of at least 4 to 5 bulbs wide and as many long. You can also plant in groups / clumps of 5 or 10 for a bouquet effect. In the Spring after flowering allow the foliage to die back naturally. Never cut the green foliage.

Plant 6 inches deep, 4 inches apart

#### **Daffodils** (Bloom time Early-Season - March/April - DEER RESISTANT)

To bloom well daffodils require about a half day of Spring sun. Like many other bulbs they should be seen as an investment in the garden. Plant them in groups of 5 for a bouquet effect. Plant them in drifts or shoals for a naturalistic effect. In the Spring after blooming always allow the green foliage to die-back (turn yellow) naturally. Never cut the foliage while it is green.

Plant large bulbs 7 inches deep, 5 inches apart.

#### **Crocus** (Bloom time Very Early-Season - Feb/March)

Plant them in any reasonably fertile, well drained soil in sun or light shade. For very early Spring bloom they should be planted in a sunny protected spot. Crocuses are ideal for rock gardens and edgings, for naturalizing in grass and for planting beneath deciduous trees and shrubs. If planted in the lawn, be sure to skip the crocus area for the first one or two mowings. Plant 3 inches deep, 3 inches apart.

#### **Blue Muscari (Grape Hyacinths)**

(Bloom time Early-Season - March/April - DEER RESISTANT)

In Holland the cobalt-blue spikes of grape hyacinths are as well known as their blooming counterparts tulips and daffodils. While they like sun, grape hyacinths thrive in almost any kind of open situation and in any kind of well drained soil. An edge of muscari lends a finishing touch to a border of mid-season tulips and they make a fine association with white and yellow daffodils. Don't be alarmed when muscari form clumps of foilage in the fall. Plant 3 inches deep, 3 inches apart.

### How to Plant 100 Bulbs in Under 30 Minutes



Excavate the 20 square foot area to be planted and thoroughly loosen the soil under the bulbs.



Place the bulbs gently in bed or hole, pointed side up, and space according to instructions



Cover bulbs with soil, using only one-half of soil removed. Press down the soil around the bulbs. If the soil is dry at the time of planting, water thoroughly. The water will wash the soil in around the bulbs, eliminating air pockets and will start the bulbs rooting. Finish covering the bulbs with the remaining soil.
