Hi Everyone,

We had our latest meeting yesterday at Sally's house with 4 of us present: Sally, John Chitwood, Julie Trent Denton and me. It was a very productive meeting and I received lots of good input from many who were not able to attend (Thank you!). Basically here's what we covered and we still have many outstanding tasks:

The **Sunday Morning** continental breakfast at the high school - we have confirmation that we can have the Commons area from 8am-11am. Golf Scramble Rebecca and Bill have been working on the scramble and preliminary information is that it will be at the OU golf course with a shotgun start at 8am. The cost will be \$55 for those interested and more information will follow. They will be soliciting volunteers to help out at the golf scramble to man the "Closest to the Pin" and "Hole in One" holes. Bill is donating a brand new driver and putter as longest drive and closest to the tee prizes. (Thanks, Bill!) They will need at least two per hole and maybe one alternate. We will probably need someone to sell things like mulligan cards, passes for guys to use the ladies tee boxes and 3 foot strings that you can use to count a putt within 3 feet as good. The money can be used for a cash prize for the winning team. OU will also donate rounds of golf as prizes. Rebecca's hubby suggested we sell the aforementioned items at the ice breaker
